New or gently used, clean Dutch Costumes may be brought to Scholte Church on Wednesday, April 3. Costumes should be on **hangers, sized, and priced** on **WITH NEW UNIVERSAL TAGS in the packet. Please fill out the tag sheet also and bring with your items. Safety pins ONLY no** straight pins which will be in the packet or at market or you may call me at the below number if you need more of anything. The Dutch Costume Committee will retain 5% of all sales to cover the cost of advertising and supplies associated with the extended sale. However, if you volunteer your time to work one of the four days of the Drop off/Market, the retainer will be reduced to 2.5%. Please price your items accordingly.

****Also**, please be aware of your sizes, for example: A size 12 is typically a size 10 fit if you are using the Dutch costume patterns.
